Application—Create Your Video

Please note that you have the choice of your area of interest. Do you like to sing but not act? That's fine! You like to entertain but not sing? We will make it work! Make this video about your strengths as an entertainer or host!

Video Guidelines:

Part 1: Introduction

Introduce yourself to us by telling us your name, age, grade, city/school, interests, hobbies, extra curricular activities, community involvement, etc. Explain your interest in being an emcee and/or performer during the retreat. This portion of your video doesn't need to drag on but we want to know you.

Part 2: Talent

This part will be the bulk of your video submission showcasing your talent. Feel free to edit in a pre-recorded video of you singing, acting, telling jokes, or emceeing an event. We would also love to see you improvise on camera. Read a short monologue, sing a hymn/clean pop song, or dance! The more you show us, the more ways we know we can use you during the weekend.

Note: Please keep all selections and language clean and appropriate; remember the event for which you are auditioning. Going Bananas for Jesus is about growing closer in a relationship with God. The Banana Bunch will help to facilitate this growth with the youth of the Grand Island Diocese.

Application—Submission

The final deadline for the Banana Bunch audition application (paper materials and video) is **September 30, 2016**.

Upload your video submission to YouTube. The upload process will require a YouTube account. After you upload the video from your computer, tablet, or phone, you will have the opportunity to select the privacy settings for the video. You may choose, "Public", "Private", or "Link Only". You may choose "Link Only" to ensure your privacy. You may upload the video file to your Google Drive and "share" with the email address below, which will also require a Google account. The final link to the video will need to be sent to **gbfjnorthplatte@gmail.com** by **September 30, 2016**.

All paper application materials need to be scanned and sent to **gbfjnorthplatte@gmail.com**. Please coordinate with your Director of Religious Education (DRE) to fill out and return his/her recommendation form. The DRE also has the opportunity to send the form in separately from your form.
