Please note the following youth and young adults who are eligible for the various Higher Ground Retreats<sup>TM</sup> experiences and what the purpose is of each program. The registration deadline for each week is the Friday **one week prior to the week they want to attend. Retreats will fill-up, so encourage early registrations.** 

HIGHER GROUND any student completing their sophomore or junior year of high school

Purpose: to learn Christian Community Building Skills.

HIGHER GROUND II any student who participated in HG or

any student who is completing their senior year of high school (they don't need to attend HG if they are graduated!)

Purpose: to learn skills in Christian Lifestyle and Discipleship.

HIGHER GROUND any student who participated in HG II or

COLLEGE RETREAT any young adult who is one year out of high school(**do not have to attend HG II**)

(ex. Finishing their freshman year of college)

Purpose: to learn tools to discern our Call to Follow Christ.

HIGHER GROUND

any student who completed 6<sup>th</sup> or 7<sup>th</sup> grade in spring of 2017

MIDDLE SCHOOL RETREAT

Purpose: create an environment where they belong and help others belong

We ask that you consider staffing Higher Ground this summer and please encourage others to staff! To be eligible for staff, applicants must be at least two years out of high school.
