Going Bananas For Jesus™ Code of Behavior



The success of Going Bananas for Jesus™ relies on everyone. The Code of Behavior has been developed as a way to help participants understand what is expected of them during this weekend conference.

- ✓ Be Respectful and Safe. At Going Bananas for Jesus™ we expect to create an environment of safety and trust. The use of our bodies, language, and humor must always honor the dignity of every person. If you jeopardize the physical, mental, or emotional safety of yourself or others, you choose to have a parent or guardian pick you up and take you home immediately.
- ✓ Be Responsible and Honest. Participants are expected to be present at all activities on time and participate fully. Established guidelines will be observed at all times. We need to take care of the building and grounds. Any damage is to be reported immediately and involved persons are financially accountable. Emergencies that involve the health and well-being of people and/or property must be reported to adult staff immediately.
- ✓ The use of illegal drugs, including alcohol, or other illegal/harmful substances is not permitted. If you use these materials, you choose to have a parent or guardian pick you up and take you home immediately. Proper authorities will be notified.
- ✓ All participants are expected to take pride in their personal appearance. Students should be clean, neat, and dressed in proper clothing. Decency and modesty should prevail. Specific attire that is not permitted.
 - Shorts which are not at least mid-thigh in length.
 - Clothing made of open mesh or sheer material or that exposes undergarments or skin such as sports bras, underwear, etc.
 - Clothing that exposes the top of shoulders, midriff, back or undergarments.
 - Pants/shorts must be worn on the hip
 - Clothing displaying indecent writing, picture, slogans, suggestive or double meaning. Any type of attire that advertises, promotes, or makes reference to drugs, alcohol, violence, tobacco or sexual acts. NO bandanas please.
 - Clothing with tears or holes that expose flesh or underclothes is not acceptable.
- ✓ Observe appropriate boundaries. All participants must stay in designated areas only. Host families will be gender specific (all males or all females). One of our goals is to relate with everyone present; therefore, during the weekend exclusive relationships are discouraged. If you engage in activities contrary to these guidelines or any activities that jeopardize your safety or the safety of others, you choose to be removed from this event and your parent or guardian will be called to pick you up and take you home immediately at their expense.
